

# RECYCLING GUIDE

## **Kraft Salad bowls (salads, pasta, poke bowl, meals – Made from recycled material lined with plant based PLA....**

- Can be gently washed and reused at home or placed in the yellow recycle bin for collection



## **Lasagne trays**

- Wash and recycle lid and base in yellow bin

## **All jars (mayonnaise, pickles, salad dressings, pesto)**

- Please wash and return to Katering at Home with the foam box. We wash, sterilised and re-use all jars. Alternatively, these jars can be placed in the household recycling bin.



## **BIOBOX salad boxes -Made from compostable sugar cane.**

- If you have a compost bin at home they can go straight into that bin, if not they can be placed into the general yellow recycling bin.



## **Ice packs**

- Return to Katering at Home – we wash, refreeze and re-use all ice packs many times over. Alternately squeeze out the gel into general waste (not suitable to go down the drain) and recycle the casing into your local soft plastics recycle bin.

Foam boxes, whilst not recyclable (unless taken to a [facility](#)) can be washed and reused so please return them to Katering at Home

Biscuit, granola and cookie packaging can be placed in recycle bins. Any soft plastics can also be placed in your local Red cycle bin.

Foil trays can be washed, flattened and placed out for household recycling

Any used PET takeaway containers can be washed and reused around the home or returned to Katering at home (we wash/sterilise and store food prep such some picked herbs, vegetables, dry stores in these containers. They can also be placed straight into household yellow recycling.

Bake boxes and loaf wrapping can all be placed in the yellow recycle bin
